	outcomes to determine where the knowledge, skills and attitudes were in the
	outcomes, and consider how these might be enacted in the music classroom.
Classroom-Based Assessment	A summary of the feedback from the previous meeting was presented, and the
	members of the group came closer to an agreement on this part of the specification.
