Consultation report on background paper	A presentation was made to the group on the Consultation Report on the Background Paper that was recently approved by NCCA Council.
Learning outcomes	 The group discussed the following: The need for learning outcomes to be accompanied by support material. The number of learning outcomes per strand. The draft learning outcomes for the <i>materials</i> strand. How best to target gaps in understanding, and how to provide sufficient challenge to each student, whilst at the same time making science accessible to all. The group split up into four teams to work on the learning outcomes for strands 2-5. The teams working on Materials, Earth and Space, and the Biological world were furnished with a first draft of learning outcomes based on feedback from the previous meeting.
Assessment for certification	 The group discussed the following as: The purpose of practical science. The assessment of practical work as part of the school-based component.

These emerging issues were identified:

- The specification and CPD will need to address the concerns expressed in the consultation report.
- The content of the specification should be framed in such a way that learners should be able to build knowledge rather than add content.

How to incorporate an element of directly assessed practical skills.

The weighting of the marks for the assessment tasks

• The adoption of a performance based assessment task could require for the tasks to be centrally devised in the initial years.
