

## LC Chemistry Development Group Meeting #2 18/11/2019

<b>Introduction</b>	Previous minutes agreed. No conflicts of interest declared.
<b>Review of draft Purpose, Aims and Objectives</b>	The group was presented uploaded version of the draft document and a revised draft informed by Biology and Physics DG second meeting. The group was divided into 4 breakout groups to discuss and record how they would re-draft. During the plenary session, their ideas and discussions were recorded by the executive. A more condensed draft was favoured, with some new edits to be drafted by the executive for consideration at the next meeting.
<b>Aim, Objectives and Key Skills</b>	The members were presented with examples of various structures, including the 2014 draft spec structures. In the same breakout groups again, they were asked to develop a structure, within the constraints of the brief and emerging purpose. Following the plenary discussion, there was some agreement on a unifying strand and that interconnection and fluidity needed to be articulated in a structure for LC Chemistry. It was agreed the executive would begin initial drafts on developing and populating the structure for the next meeting.
