<p>Housekeeping, governance, minutes, Matters arising</p>	<p>Short amendment to minutes to say that one group of members felt there was a general consensus that coursework should be primarily laboratory-based and another group of members felt there was no consensus on the nature of the coursework reflecting the plurality of the discussion.</p> <p>Otherwise minutes approved and no conflicts of interest declared.</p>
<p>Changes to the contextual strands</p>	<p>Discussions on gender balance and readability of the draft specification.</p> <p>A discussion document outline the following suggestions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Change the numbering of the LOs to create better connections between the 2 columns • Re-define the action verb model to reflect both quantitative and qualitative aspects, and to replace the less concise usage in previous drafts. • Make clearer links between verifying models using primary data and the LOs in the unifying strands. <p>Chair concluded there was consensus these changes improved the draft specification.</p> <p>Specific changes and feedback to the contextual strands were agreed such as the relationships between pressure, density and force, conservation of momentum in 2-dimensions, treatment of SI units in NoS strand is sufficient, more precise use of the word elastic and clarification on what is meant by secondary data.</p>
