<b>Strand discussion</b>		There was a presentation on worked examples of the strands based on the discussions from the last meeting.
<b>Working groups strand content and feedback</b>		There was extensive discussion on the strands and optionality. The preference of the majority of the group was that optionality was to be retained in the structure of the course. Further discussions centred on the date ranges, focus of contexts, geographical spread of contexts and the lenses through which contextual events are examined.
